



Washington University Occupational Health Services will be sponsoring mandatory Tuberculosis (TB) testing/ screening for certain Washington University School of Medicine employees on the main medical school campus. *TB screening is mandatory for those healthcare workers who have direct patient care; work in a patient care setting or who have direct human research subject contact at the main campus location.* This requirement is especially important for those who have direct patient care at Barnes Jewish(BJH) , St. Louis Children’s Hospital(SLCH), The Center for Advanced Medicine (CAM), and The Center for Outpatient Health (COH). BJH and SLCH employees (as well as residents) should contact their employer to obtain TB testing.

Employees will be given a TB testing form for the reading of the PPD. The TB test can be read and the form completed by another Wash U or BJC medical doctor or registered nurse. Any measurement reading greater than 0mm will need an evaluation in our office. Self-reading is not allowed.

Please see the schedule below for the TB testing dates. If you have received a TB test in the past 3 months from another source or from BJH, please send the documentation to Occupationalhealthservice@wusm.wustl.edu

Employees with a history of a positive skin test documented with WUSM Occupational Health will not have to have the test repeated. However, you must sign a reactor form reviewing the symptoms of TB annually. (If you do not have documentation of a positive TB test on file with Occupational Health, please do not submit this form)
